The bargaining team is pleased to report some modest progress from our first real bargaining session on Monday afternoon. We came to agreement on a couple of "housekeeping" issues. It's hard to call this substantial progress, but even these early discussions are giving the team a clearer overall understanding of the employer's position and its broader goals for this round of bargaining. Some of their proposals seem reasonable, while others seem to be inspired by some of the most worrying employer trends in the university sector.

The issues are complicated, but they have major implications for the way our members do their jobs and their status as academic professionals.
